Fire: we had a garage fire on Chenango St (740) on March 11. The fire was challenging as it was wind driven due to extremely high winds that day causing it to go from a small brush fire to a fully involved garage fire in a matter of minutes, before we could even respond. We were on scene within 7 minutes and deployed 6 hose lines to get the fire under control. The March report reflects the fire loss of \$45k for the garage lost and neighboring garage and house that were damaged, but also reflects the \$250k property saved but preventing the fire from spreading to the two houses right in front of it.
