During the last 5 years we have had 3 tax decreases and 2 years with no increase. This year we need to raise our taxes slightly. The increase will equate to approximately \$18.60 annually per average home.

# HELP YOUR POLICE <u>DEPARTMENT HELP YOU.</u> If you See something, say something!

#### PLEASE CALL THE POLICE IF YOU SEE OR HEAR ANY SUSPICIOUS OR UNUSUAL ACTIVITY.

No call is too small, and no need to provide your name when reporting.

**POLICE DEPARMENT**: Will be vigorously enforcing the State & Village Laws regarding illegal loud vehicles. The Police are now operating a Decibel Meter and will be enforcing the Decibel Limit of 60 DBA during the day and 50 at night in residential areas. **PLEASE TAKE NOTE** 

- <u>UNLOCKED VEHICLES ARE BEING</u> <u>ENTERED.</u> LOCK YOUR VEHICLE & YOUR HOME.
- <u>CLOSE YOUR GARAGE DOORS</u> when no one is at home as you are inviting theft.
- DO NOT LEAVE BICYCLES AND OTHER VALUABLE ITEMS OUTSIDE AT NIGHT.

<u>NOTE</u>: If you have a situation such as sewer or water problem when the Village Office is closed, please call the PD Police 607-722-1255, state your problem to the dispatcher and a Port Dickinson Officer will contact you to resolve your situation.

# FIRES & OPEN BURNING:

The burning of garbage, rubbish & lawn debris in any manner at any time is prohibited in the Village.

NYS Open Burn Ban is March 15 to May 15.

# YARD WASTE PICKUP BEGINS TUESDAY APRIL 8

<u>Cut grass will be collected on Tuesdays in April</u> and May but grass collection ends May 27. Remaining lawn debris will be collected. (For information on grass composting contact Broome County Cooperative Extension on Front St.)

#### ALL DEBRIS MUST BE IN SOLID CONTAINERS. Max. 40lbs. No overweight containers. <u>NO PLASTIC</u> <u>BAGS. BRANCHES MUST BE TIED IN 4 FT.</u> <u>LENGTHS or IN CONTAINERS</u>. Place containers between the sidewalk and the curb <u>after 2PM the day</u> <u>prior to collection.</u>

Please note due to the Holidays 5/26 pickup will be 5/27. and 9/2 will be 9/3.

# Last Yard Waste pickup October 7

#### IT IS ILLEGAL TO DISCHARGE GRASS, LAWN DEBRIS AND SNOW INTO THE STREET.

<u>TREE TRIMMING</u>: It is the homeowner's responsibility to trim trees on their property to allow for a min. of 7 feet of clearance over the sidewalk & street.

# **BUILDING PERMITS are MANDATORY:**

**The following require permits (not limited to)** New Structures/Construction/Additions, Pools, Decks, Certain Size Sheds, Hot Tubs, Fireplace/ Wood Burners, and \*Handicap Ramps. *TOTAL ROOF REPLACEMENT AND ALL FENCES NOW REQUIRE PERMITS PER NYS*.

CALL THE BUILDING INSPECTOR 771-8233 WITH ANY QUESTIONS <u>PRIOR.</u> THIS WILL ALLOW YOU TO AVOID DELAYS, LEGAL ACTION & ADDED COSTS. Please allow time for the Inspector to return your call. You can download an application on the Village website or pick up permit applications at the Village Hall.
