In court for 19 Bromley, owner provided a signed contract with Delta Engineering for garage survey, provided paid receipt for vinyl siding for the west side of the home, replaced 2 more windows on the west side of the home

Performed numerous site inspections and issued building permits for roofing due to 7/3/25 storm.

Issued Unregistered vehicle and paint violations to 1 Phelps St. Owner has provided valid registration documents for the vehicles. In court for paint of the house, owner has completed the main house painting and has window and door trim to finish. Also issued a separate violation for the downed tree and weed in side yard. Owner will have the tree cut up and placed at curb for pick up by end of yard waste season.

3 River St weeds and painting is now complete. Will speak with the owner about some small debris items stored in the driveway

In court for 24 River St pool violation. Owner plead not guilty and is making attempts to borrow funds from a family member for a hard cover. She installed a tarp/water bag cover over the pool however the pool does not hold water so the tarp falls inside


