§ 45-3. Regulations.

- 2 (a) All fences shall be constructed of wood, chain link, wrought iron, or PVC permanent fencing material. Materials such as sheet metal, razor wire, page wire, pallets, doors, old building materials or non-traditional fencing materials are prohibited. Temporary fences are permitted only for the duration of a construction project. **[Amended 7/12/22, LL 6-2022]**

(b) All fences, walls and hedges shall be maintained by the person responsible for the property. Such maintenance shall include, but not be limited to, painting and replacement or repair of fences that fall into disrepair.

(c) To ensure traffic and pedestrian safety and visibility, when any portion of a fence, wall or hedge is located within the front yard or within six (6) feet of any sidewalk or street, no such portion of said fence shall exceed three (3) feet in height.**[added 1/14/25, LL 3-3025]**

(d) No fence, wall or hedge shall exceed six (6) feet in height. A maximum of four (4) inches of ground clearance and a maximum of eight (8) inches of decorations, lights, or other fixtures is allowed to be placed on top of the fence, such that the combined maximum height of a fence with ground clearance and decorations, lights or other fixtures shall not exceed seven (7) feet. **[added 1/14/25, LL3-2025]**
